Position Title: Dental Hygienist

General Summary: The Dental Hygienist is responsible for providing dental hygiene services to low-income, uninsured clinic patients. The Dental Hygienist works in conjunction with clinic staff and volunteer dentists to improve or maintain periodontal health and provided patient education.

Principal Duties and Responsibilities:

A. Patient Care

- 1. Prior to treatment, takes and records medical and dental histories, vital signs, and other information that may affect treatment.
- 2. Provides soft tissue examination: palpates and visually examines intra-oral/extra-oral tissues for irregularities and signs of disease.
- Documents conditions of dental decay and disease for diagnosis and treatment by dentist.
- Assesses the oral health of patients through medical and dental histories, radiographs, indices, risk assessments, and intra-oral and extra-oral procedures and describes the oral health needs of patients.
- 5. Performs dental hygiene procedures which may include periodontal debridement (scaling, root planing, curettage, and polishing).
- 6. Develops and implements a dental hygiene plan of care.
- 7. Educates patients on healthy life choices and oral hygiene practices for at-home care.
- 8. Re-evaluation of oral and periodontal health following the implementation of the care plan to identify the subsequent treatment, continued care, and referral needs of the patient.
- 9. As authorized by a Wisconsin licensed dentist:
 - a. Administer local anesthetic agents if licensed to do so.
 - b. Place pit and fissure sealants.
 - c. Expose and develop radiographs.
 - d. Remove sutures and change dressings

B. Record and Work Space Maintenance

- 1. Documents services rendered and related information following each appointment.
- 2. Maintains asepsis during all procedures.

- 3. Maintains the operatory.
- 4. Creates a friendly, comfortable setting in which the patient can feel supported and cared for.
- 5. Conforms to local, state, regional, and national regulatory agency policies.
- C. Continuous Quality Improvement and Project Reporting
 - 1. Works with Executive Director and Clinic Manager to develop and implement a continuous quality improvement plan.
 - 2. Assists the executive director with reporting and quality improvement efforts as required by funders.
- D. Ethics and Leadership make decisions and demonstrate ethical and positive actions
 - 1. Maintain patient confidentiality.
 - 2. Deliver care in non-judgmental and non-discriminatory manner.
 - 3. Participate in orientation of new employees and act as role model and resource for patients, coworkers and volunteers.
 - 4. Ensure teamwork of staff and volunteers that is mission focused.
- E. Environmental Safety/Resource Utilization take active part in maintaining safe, comfortable and therapeutic environment for patients, visitors and staff.
 - 1. Deliver care safely and in accordance with safety policies & procedures.
 - 2. Maintain a safe work and patient environment.
 - 3. Recognize potential environmental problems and report to appropriate personnel.
 - 4. Coordinate annual CPR training for staff.
- F. Other duties as assigned

Job Qualifications and Specifications:

- 1. Active Wisconsin Dental Hygienist licenses required.
- 2. Two years of experience as a Dental Hygienist.
- 3. Maintains professional liability malpractice insurance for scope of licenses.
- 4. Bilingual in English and Spanish desirable.
- 5. Ability to communicate effectively and relate to individuals from various economic, social and cultural backgrounds. Ability to provide courtesy under pressure.
